

a saline solution. Nevertheless, some hospital treatment was required. Sealed plastic bottles of sterile eye-wash are available from your local pharmacy. It would be prudent to carry at least one in your model box, with your club having several more in the first aid kit at the field for ready use. Flushing the affected eye for at least fifteen minutes is necessary. If the sterile solution is not available, use clean, fresh water.

The Nats organisers warned, both in the printed programme and at the contestants' briefing, of the danger of heat stress and of sunburn. My fellow prisoners in the pylon cages heeded the warning and applied sun block lotion several times during the day(s). They were also

grateful for the cold drinks provided, as it turned out, at the expense of the RCAS[NSW] President, John Chadd. As one recipient of them, I say "Thank you, John".

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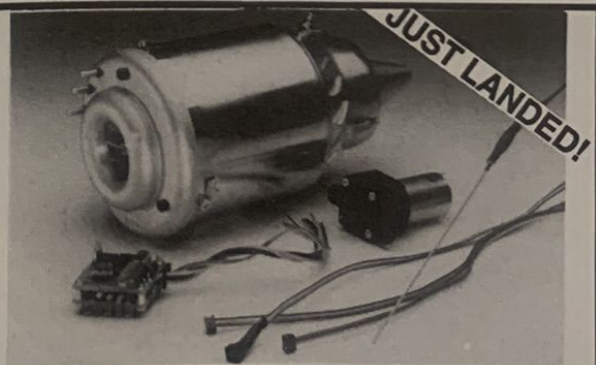
